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## **ABOUT US**

Snyman Hunting Safaris is a family business owned by the Snyman Family. Wikus and Claudine Snyman will be your hosts for your stay and safari at Nek, South Africa. Through generations and after many years of hard work this farm has been built from scratch to almost 16000 ha of prime land. Although it's traditional farming land the hunt takes place all over the 16000ha.

The sole purpose of our Safari is to give our clients an unbelievable African hunting and nature experience. All safaris are fully guided, tailored and personalized for hunters and non-hunters, so your safari can be very flexible.

To us fair chase and ethical hunting is very important, its one of the reasons why we are members of PHASA (Professional Hunters Association of South Africa) and live by their code of conduct.

Snyman Hunting Safaris is situated in the Northern Cape Province of South Africa between Upington and Kimberley, which are a Malaria free area.

### **PHASA CODE OF ETHICS**

Recognizing my status as a Member of this organization and therefore my responsibility to wildlife, habitat, client and future generations, I pledge to conduct myself professionally in a manner which will reflect honesty, integrity and morality. In the spirit of fair chase, the principle of sustainable utilization of our natural resources will be adhered to, and I adhere to the following principles:

1. Obey all laws of the land;
2. Will not misrepresent myself to clients in any way or mislead any client;
3. Will not allow material gain to supercede principles of fair chase;
4. Will not hunt any wild animal which is not normally self-sustainable nor in its natural state;
5. Will at all times employ humane hunting practices;
6. Will not hunt female wild animals with dependent offspring;
7. Will not allow a client to shoot at animals at a distance beyond the capability of their competence or that client's equipment;
8. Will respect local communities' property and input.

## **FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS**

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### **What important health issues are there?**

No vaccinations or inoculations are required coming into South Africa. We hunt in a malaria free environment. Tap water is safe to drink but some visitors prefer to drink the excellent locally bottled or imported mineral water that is readily available.

### **What is the climate like?**

South Africa has a wide range of climate zones, although generally it may be considered to have a moderate climate. Nights during winter (April to August) can be very cold but the days are fine, between 5 and 25°C. Summer days from August to April could reach 35°C. It is advisable to wear sunscreen and a hat during your hunting safari in South Africa.

### **Is it safe to come to South Africa?**

Crime and security in South Africa are much debated both locally and by the international media. One has to be careful and we won't take you to high risk areas and we'll try to ensure your safety.

### **What clothing should I bring?**

Comfortable clothing in neutral shades would be ideal. Some hunters use camouflage clothing that is always a winner for hunting. Make sure that you bring along well-broken-in walking shoes/boots for walking and stalking. Remember to wear a hat because of the sun and something warm for the early mornings/late afternoons or nights.

### **What type of terrain will I be hunting in?**

It depends on the game being hunted. It could be on open grass plains for springbok, Kalahari dunes for gemsbok, rocky terrain for mountain reed buck and acacia type bushveld for a variety of other game.

### **What happens to the meat of the game I shoot?**

The meat stays the property of Snyman Hunting Safaris. It will be used for some of the meals at the lodge; the staff will use some and the rest will be sold and processed for the consumer market. Nothing will be wasted.

## **How may I pay in South Africa?**

The currency used in South Africa is the Rand. It is advisable to use traveler's cheques as far as possible and not to carry large amounts of cash.

Most major banks exchange traveler's cheques for cash. ATM's are virtually everywhere for credit card use and there are Bureau de Change in all airports and major centers. We accept traveler's cheques, cash and bank drafts as payment. Unfortunately we do not take credit cards.

## **What about electricity?**

We have full 220v electricity at the lodge. Adapter plugs will be provided.

## **What about importing my own rifle?**

Visitors bringing in firearms into South Africa for hunting purposes will need to fill in the SAP 520 form – Temporary Importation Application which is available at [www.saps.gov.za](http://www.saps.gov.za). This form can also be filled in on arrival.

### **Instruction for filling in the SAP 520 form:**

- Use only black ink to fill in the form
- The form must be left unsigned
- The document is finalized and signed in front of the police official issuing the actual permit.
- Visitors bringing in their own firearms for hunting should concentrate on filling In the following sections:
  - Section D
  - Section E -1 -25.4
  - Section G
  - Section I (must fill in all details requested)
  - Section J (Remember not to complete until in front of the officer at the firearms Office)

### **Additional Requirements along with the SAP 520 are the following**

- Identity and flight details
  - Passport and return airline ticket
- Supporting documents
  - Proof of ownership of firearm
  - Documentary proof showing that the owner is 21 or older
  - Proof of export from the country of origin example. USA, UK
  - Motivation letter from the hunter (client) that he is temporarily importing the firearms for the purpose of hunting (list the species of animals) and the details of Snyman Hunting Safaris.
  - Invitation letter from Snyman Hunting Safaris (Outfitter) which will include the

- following: Full name of company, contact details, address and dates.  
Location of actual hunt and details of the firearms that will be used.  
(serial number and caliber)
- Firearms will be physically inspected to ensure that the serial numbers match the paperwork. Ammunition will also be inspected. Please note that not more than 200 rounds per firearm will be allowed.

**PROHIBITED FIREARMS – NOT TO BE IMPORTED INTO RSA**  
**Any fully automatic or semi automatic weapon**  
**Handguns for self defense**  
**Weapons that fall the under military category.**

**Procedure for arrivals at Johannesburg International Airport**

- clear passport control in the terminal where your flight arrives
- proceed to baggage claim. Pick up general baggage. Proceed to the respective Airline help desk to pick up the firearms and sign a receipt thereof. Ask for assistance at the desk where the South African Police Firearms office is.
- proceed to SAP Firearms Office. Do not at this point go to customs
- on receipt of the temporary import permit at the SAPS office then proceed to Customs RED ZONE where you would declare the firearms.

We will meet you as soon as you leave customs.

**What if I bring a bow with?**

There's no permit required or any charge by the South African Police Service for a bow.

## HUNTING

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### • Bow Hunting

We specialize in bow hunting and know what it takes to obtain a trophy using a bow. We have areas that are set aside for bow hunting only and other areas are suitable for both.

Bow hunting is primarily done from behind built in blinds and is set up at waterholes. Shots are normally 20 to 25 yards for those with enough patience there is walking and stalking. A quiet, fast bow/cross bow with sharp fixed blades broad heads will be sufficient for most animals.

Please contact us to find out if your equipment is suitable for the game you're after.

### • Rifle Hunting

To maximize your hunt of a lifetime in Africa, rifle hunting is mostly done on foot or by means of spot and stalk. This depends on the client's ability, the terrain, and the animal hunted. .30 Caliber or bigger is a good all-rounder for plains game with at least 60 cartridges. Rifle hiring is also available. Talk to us about smaller calibers for women and children.

The animals that call the African bush home are tough and therefore only premium grade bullets must be used. Barnes X is always a winner. Importation of firearms is made easy by pre-arranging your importation permit, which we will help you with.
